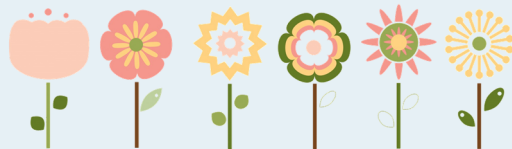

## Our Services

Services Include:

- Consulting and designing before planting begins.
- Supplying all top soil and mulch.
- Supplying and planting of all flowers and shrubs.
- Fertilizing, watering, weeding, pruning, and trimming of gardens throughout the entire season.
- Cleaning up of flower beds in the Fall.
